



Title: Isolation Area Laundry Technician
Supervisor: Intake Manager and Supervisor

Overview: The laundry technician will be responsible for ensuring dirty laundry from all adoptable animal and isolation areas is sorted, washed, dried, folded and stored. The technician will also assist with sorting any donated laundry to ensure it is appropriate for use at the shelter.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Sort, wash, dry, fold and store all laundry
2. Ensure laundry detergent and bleach is fully stocked
3. Sort donated laundry to determine if it is appropriate for use at the shelter

Training:

1. Complete a volunteer orientation
2. Attend an introductory meeting with the volunteer coordinator
3. Receive on-the-job training from staff during first shift

Qualifications:

1. Must be 16 years of age to work without direct supervision by a parent or legal guardian

Skills:

1. Ability to comfortably work in a small room that can be warm at times
2. Be comfortable bending over for periods of time
3. Ability to follow directions

Commitment:

- **Length of time:** Minimum of two shifts per month with minimum four month time committment
- **Amount of time:** One hour shifts
- **Times Requested:** Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 2:00 – 3:00pm
- **Location:** Brunswick Shelter (30 Range Road, Brunswick) and Edgecomb Shelter (27 Atlantic Highway, Edgecomb)
