



Keep It Clean Crew (Cats)

Overview: Keep it clean crew provides daily cleaning assistance to our adoptions staff. With support of the Volunteer Manager and Adoptions Leadership, these volunteers work side by side with our staff to ensure every animal in our care has a clean living space, toys and bedding, and food and water.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Providing food and water for cats and kittens in our care
- Scooping, cleaning, and sanitizing litter boxes
- Replacing linens and bedding
- Sweeping and moping cat rooms
- Assist in dishes and laundry as needed
- Follow all disease control protocols as directed by shelter staff
- Follow all Midcoast Humane policies and procedures regarding shelter cleaning

Training:

- Complete 2 shadow shifts with shelter staff or Keep It Clean Crew volunteer
- Complete check-in with Volunteer Manager after 12 hours of service

Physical Demands

- Ability to lift and/or restrain up to 15lbs
- Ability to work in an environment where you will be exposed to strong smells, animal waste, and potentially hazardous conditions, including the risk of animal bites
- Walking for periods on time with frequent bending, kneeling, stooping and reaching
- Must be over 16 years of age, or 13 with guardian

Commitment:

- Must commit to one shift per week for 6 months

Edgecomb: Monday - Sunday 9:00am – 11:00am
